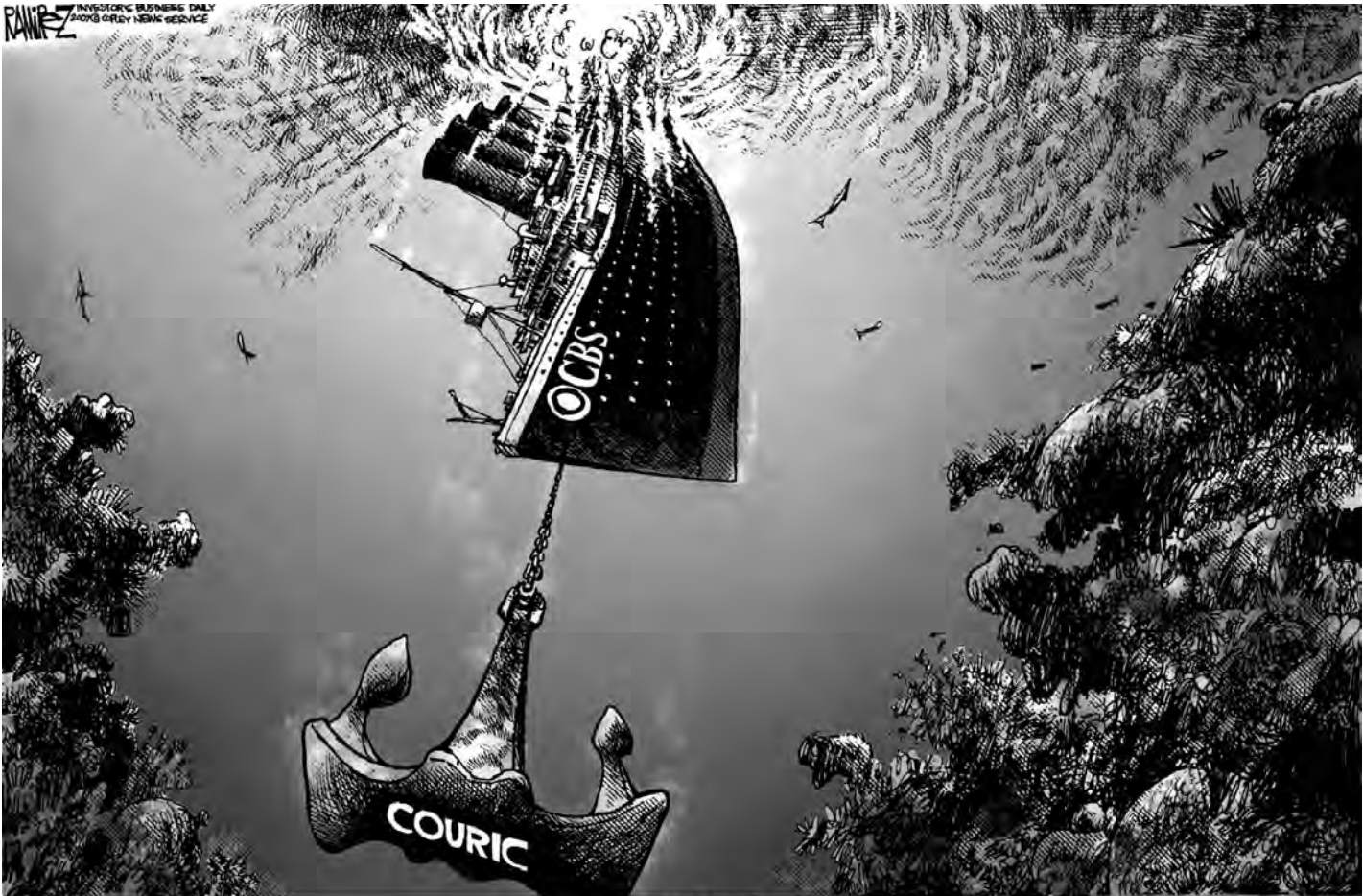
MICHAEL RAMIREZ

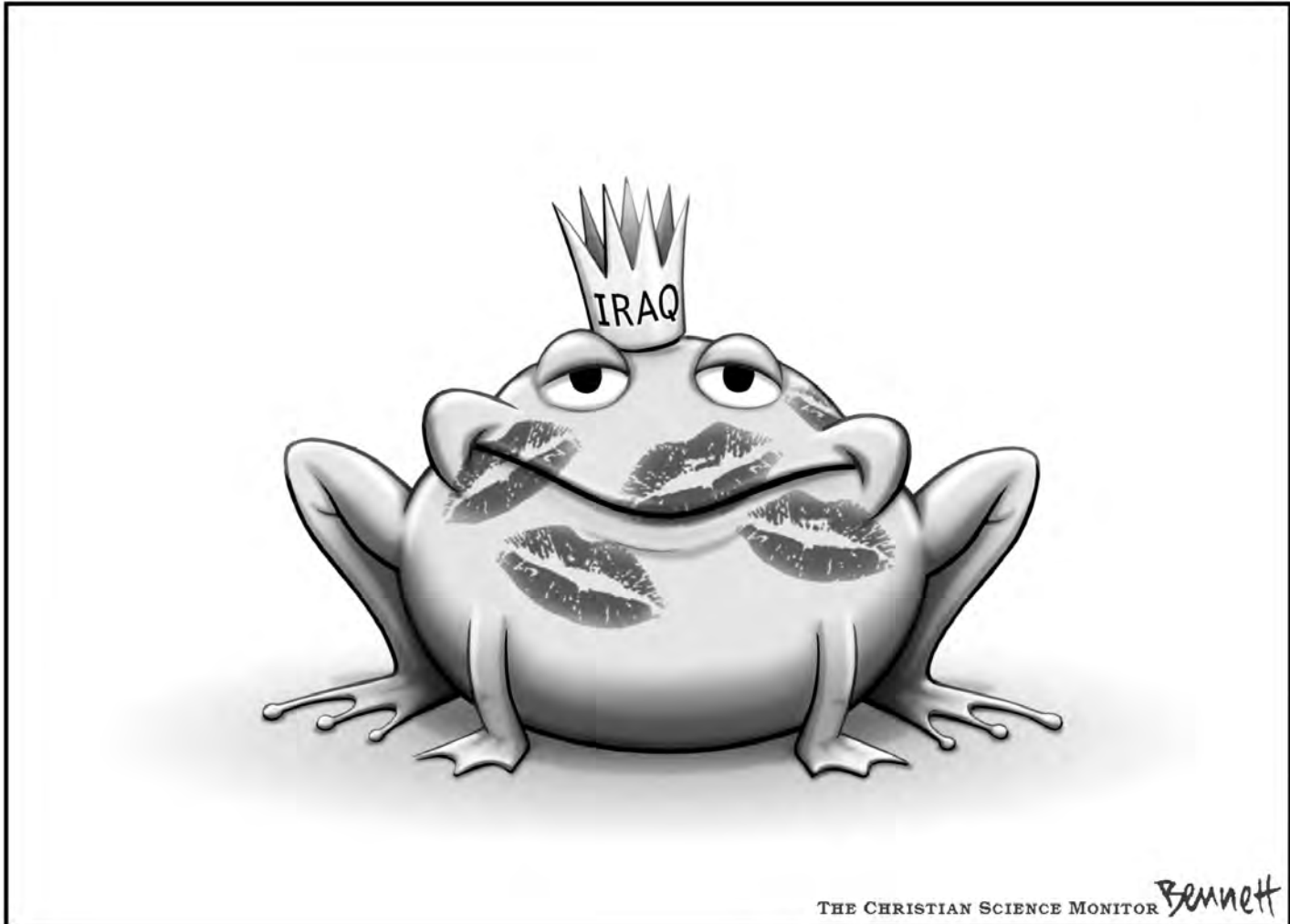


MIKE PETERS
